No	Questions / Tasks / Activities / Discussion Points
1.	<p>CHECK OUT the ‘Re-cap’ Video from Jordan as he introduces the theme God’s Grand Design / Dream to Design.</p> <p>You may also want to check out the full sermon on RLC’s Website or You Tube channel.</p>
2.	<p>Did you know this God has a ‘grand design’ for each of our lives! We don’t believe that our lives are a mix of random coincidences and luck but we believe that God has designed, purposed and ordained each day we live.</p> <p>READ Spend some time reading out Psalm 139: 13-16 (you can read the whole Psalm if you want to).</p>
3.	<p>DISCUSSION What does this Psalm mean to you? What do we learn about God? What do we learn about ourselves?</p>
4.	<p>PONDER / DISCUSS / REFLECT What is your dream? Is your dream worth sacrificing everything for? If your dream became reality would it impact the world or just your world? Is your dream selfish or selfless? What do you think God’s dream is? What does God want?</p>
5.	<p>CONSIDER CT Studd – A British missionary to China in the late 1800s said: “If Jesus Christ be God and died for me then no sacrifice is to great for me to make for Him.” What do you think this means?</p>
6.	<p>READ Habakkuk 2:1-4 Why is it important to write down your dream?</p>

7.	DISCUSS Why is it good to partner with and include others in our dreams? Genesis 2:18
8.	Who is our greatest partner? Who enables our dreams and visions that we have to become a reality? READ 1 Corinthians 3:5-9
9.	PRAY Have you got a dream? Maybe it is time to start dreaming again. Joel 2:28 – Your old men will dream dreams and your young men will see visions.
